A staff council meeting has been convened by IQAC with all the in-charges / heads of the departments under the chairmanship of the principal to bring feedback analysis to their notice with a request to find out the possibility for effective changes offered by their respective departments.


The Heads of the Departments in turn have conducted a meeting in their departments and explored the possibility of action plan to be implemented in accordance with the demands of the stake holders.

Students Feedback above 90% is considered as a positive feedback and below that as a negative feedback and we are working for the improvement. Out of Ten Questions, concerns were expressed only on **Three Questions** while on the other **Seven Questions** got positive feedback on which we will continue the same rigor to maintain the same output.

1	How do you rate the relevance of the curriculum and syllabi to the courses?	Excellent	<u>91.45%</u>	We will continue the same rigor to maintain the same output.
2	How do you rate the extent of syllabi covered in the class?	Good	<u>91.37%</u>	To ensure the syllabus is covered well in advance and allow enough buffer to revise and identify weak students. We aim to get a feedback of 98% or above.
3	How do you rate the offering of the electives in terms of relevancy to the curriculum?	Good	<u>90.37%</u>	We will work towards having more options in electives.
4	How do you rate the usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching?	Good	<u>90.09%</u>	In the dynamic environment of SRK, we will be on our toes to keep up to the pace of most advanced tools in ICT and will employ them.

5	How do you rate the transparency in the assessment processes?	Average	<u>90.78%</u>	We welcome the feedback. We will make the process more transparent by considering the academic grievances of the students dropped in the suggestion box and action plan will be taken.
6	How do you rate the opportunities in the college for research activities?	Average	<u>88.22%</u>	We believe research is the first step for innovation. We will provide a platform for sharing available research facilities.
7	How do you rate the promptness in evaluating the answer scripts?	Good	<u>89.48%</u>	We will continue the carefulness and ensure the answer sheets are promptly evaluated.
8	How do you rate the out of class room learning (guest lectures, seminars, workshop, value added programmes, conferences, competitions)	Good	<u>88.30%</u>	We are working with visiting professors to visit us for guest lectures.
9	How do you rate the opportunity for students to participate in internship, student exchange and field visit?	Average	<u>88.96%</u>	We are working with companies to facilitate field visits for our students.
10	How do you rate the size of the syllabus in terms of load on the student?	Good	<u>88.65%</u>	We have limited control on the syllabus. However, based on the feedback we will recommend to the university.

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
